RISING STARS SKILL DEVELOPMENT - For Boys & Girls Ages 9-17 years-old beginning November 9 and Ending Feb. 12 (There will be no classes on Holidays: Nov. 25 & 26, Dec. 12 – Jan. 1, Jan. 18)

General Skills Classes: JG skill trainers will teach basketball fundamentals of ball handling, passing, shooting and offensive footwork to kids from ages 9-12.

(Kids will be broken into age appropriate groups). **This class will be taught by Kurt Vahle, former Trinity International University player and one of the best young instructors in Chicago who has ran camps for the Chicago Bulls Academy and Joy of The Game.**

Shooting Classes: This class will focus on teaching the fundamentals of shooting, shooting footwork, and shooting off of the dribble to boys and girls players between the ages of 11-17. **This class will be taught by Michael Weinstein who is the founder of Joy of The Game and has been coaching basketball for the past 17 years. Coach Weinstein has sent over 100 players on to play college basketball.**
