## FEB 12TH RECAP

Perhaps Bruce Weber should take a page out of THE LEAGUE's Fighting Illini playbook. The mini Illini are off to a perfect 2-0 in Big 10 play after trouncing rival Purdue 37-16 at Joy Of The Game last week. Though the two sides were even early, Illinois turned up the intensity and scoring in the second half behind the play of Freddy Durbin, who finished with a game high 18 points. Felix Rosen would add eight for the victors while Purdue, now 0-2, received six points from Jonah Nathan.

Iowa may not have played a complete game, but the Hawkeyes surely did enough to win last week, downing the Indiana Hoosiers 21-14 at the Basketball Warehouse. Iowa cruised in the second half after owning a 17-6 lead at halftime; the Hawkeyes held the Hoosiers scoreless in the first quarter. Devin Reisman led all scorers with nine points and Charlie Kanter finished with seven for Iowa. Indiana did outscore the Hawkeyes by five points in the fourth quarter; Justin Curran led the team with five.

And though they didn't know it at the time, Wisconsin needed a win to keep pace with the undefeated Illini and Hawkeyes. Someone must have tipped the Badgers off to the notion because they stormed through the Buckeyes last week at CHA, winning 47-24 behind eight points from George Grunditz and six each from Jack Sullivan, Christian Tan and Carlo Tan. Ohio State's Igor Bereslavsky was the only one in double digits, finishing with 12 points and a pair of three pointers; Grant Kim added eight.
