FEB 12TH RECAP

Without hesitation, Oregon has run out in front of the PAC 12 standings as the Ducks have begun the season 2-0 following last week's 27-21 triumph over the USC Trojans at Joy Of The Game. Tyler Van Gorp scored 10 points to lead the victors while Alex Fern added six; both Jacob Cohn and Jacob Fisher scored four points. For USC, most of its offense came thanks to Michael Essig who lead all scorers with 14 points, ten of which came in the second half. Just Pippen was next in line with four points.

After losing to Oregon in its opening week contest, the Stanford Cardinal bounced back in a big way. Stanford locked down on defense and limited Arizona State to just four first half points en route to a 25-13 win in Deerfield. Bronson Bartuch put on a scoring clinic in the second half, tallying 11 of his game high 13 points down the stretch; Zach Garland added eight for Stanford. The duo of Ryan Krauss and Jeff Lefkovitz combined for eight points for Arizona State; Brandon Rieger added three points.

Over at the Basketball Warehouse in Northbrook, the contest between Washington and Arizona was certainly a tale of two halves. The first belonged to the Wildcats, who opened up a 15-4 halftime advantage. However, the Huskies rallied over the final two quarters to outscore Arizona 14-2 and win the game 18-17. Seven different players scored for Washington; Dylan Katz and Stephen Sinclair both finished with four points. Arizona was led by Myles Cohen who collected 10 points in the loss.
